## REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- **Age Requirements:**
  - Kindergarten – MUST be 5 years old on or before September 1. Exceptions cannot be made.
- **Birth and Baptismal Certificates:**
  - All new students in your family will need to provide an official copy of the County Birth Certificate and a Baptismal Certificate (if Catholic) with this registration form.
- **Dental, Eye and Physical Examinations:**
  - All medical forms can be found on School Speak and must be dated within 1 year **prior to the first day of school**.
  - Dental examinations are required for students entering kindergarten, second and sixth grades. Please submit this to the school office **before the first day of attendance**.
  - Kindergarten students must have an Eye Exam on file in the school office **before the first day of attendance**.
  - Students entering preschool, kindergarten, 6th grade and ALL NEW students must have a State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination turned into the school office **before the first day of attendance**.
  - Annual IHSA Sports Physicals or a State of Illinois Health Exam is required **prior to participation** in any practices or games for student athletes in 5, \*6, 7, & 8th grade. Please note: these forms expire annually.
  - \*6th grade students: The required State of Illinois physical exam that is required to enter into 6th grade includes the IHSA sports physical requirements; therefore, a separate sports physical is not needed for those participating in sports.
- **Additional Family Information:**
  - If child is not living with both parents, please provide documentation of legal custody. In case of divorce, a copy of the court custody agreement is **REQUIRED** to be on file in the school office.
- **Tuition/ Financial Assistance:**
  - *2019-2020 Tuition rates will be released at a later date. Please note, the enrollment numbers are calculated into the budget which helps determine tuition rates. Please return this form by January 25, 2019.*
  - Information regarding financial assistance is available on School Speak. **The application deadline is March 1<sup>st</sup>**
